

Joleté - Old French for "Happy Gathering" - produces high-quality Pinot Noir & Cabernet Sauvignon, with the goal of providing high-value retail wines & restaurant by-the-glass selections.



2017 Cabernet Sauvignon "Wallula Vineyard"

The meticulously farmed Wallula Vineyard is located in "The Benches" of Horse Heaven Hills, a prominent area above the Columbia River with extraordinary soil - a mix of glacial marine sediments left behind by the ancient Missoula floods. Planted in 1997 with Southern-facing vines at approx. 1100ft., Wallula has become one of the most sought-after vineyards in the state. The vineyard's proximity to the river is ideal, acting as an insulator from heat by day and providing a cooling effect at night.

In 1998, winemaker Bret Isenhower began production in Walla Walla, Washington with a clear philosophy - produce wines with a lightness of touch and a depth of character. Because of this approach, Joleté Wines began working hand-in-hand with Brett starting with the 2015 vintage. At harvest we seek to emphasize bright acidity, tension, and a lower extraction of tannins to produce a premium wine at an exceptional value.
