2021 Joleté Pinot Noir "Le Verre Cuvée"

The 2021 Joleté Le Verre Cuvée, meaning "The Glass", is an enticing glass of Oregon Pinot Noir - aromas of raspberry and rose petal lead to a palate of red cherry and pomegranate, with subtle hints of orange peel and caramel. A wonderfully bright lift of acidity maintains perfect balance throughout the finish.

The Pinot Noir grapes were sourced from multiple AVAs in the Willamette Valley, including Yamhill-Carlton, Ribbon Ridge, and the Chehalem Mountains. This variety of source vineyards delivers complexity and nuance to the wine by bringing together both marine sediment and volcanic soil. This is a very enjoyable, approachable Pinot Noir from the excellent 2021 Oregon vintage.
